In accordance with the decision of the Directors of the CBC on 29th October 2010 the above mandatory Championship defences are put out for negotiations/purse offers.

In both cases Promoters/Managers/Matchmakers will have until the Purse Bid deadline to agree terms by negotiation and submit signed copy contracts to the Hon Secretary. In the event that voluntary agreement is not possible Purse Bids will be opened and the highest bid, submitted within the strict terms applicable to Purse Bids, will secure the right to promote the contest for the successful Promoter. Any bid submitted, not complying with these terms will be disqualified. In addition, the following applies specifically to these 2 contests :-

Other than by agreement of both parties the contests cannot take place before Saturday 22nd January 2011

The contests must take place before 31st March 2011 although the CBC will permit a modest extension to this date provided both parties agree or the successful bidding Promoter has notified the Hon Secretary prior to 6 00pm Wednesday 8th December (British time)

Bids must be delivered personally, or by a representative or by a reputable carrier (FEDEX, UPS or similar) in an envelope marked clearly on the outside 'PURSE BID - TO BE OPENED BY MR BROOK-SMITH PERSONALLY 12 00 MIDDAY FRIDAY 10TH DECEMBER 2010'

Any Promoter wishing to bid for both contests must ensure that each bid is in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside with appropriate Boxers initials eg CE/AS and/or DV/BU although both sealed envelopes may be in one large envelope/package for the purpose of consignment.

Bids must be received at Mr Brook-Smiths' address no later than 12 00 MIDDAY (BRITISH TIME) FRIDAY 10TH DECEMBER 2010 and any bid received after this time will not be opened. The address is :-
