CRUISERWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIP DECLARED VACANT

Shane Cameron of New Zealand having failed to defend the Title since it was won last year, and with an apparent commitment to box for an IBO 'World' Title, this Championship has been declared vacant.

The Champion was required to defend the Title by the end of September 2012, a deadline ordered by the CBC Directors following their last meeting in April.

The first matching, approved by the CBC and in accordance with CBC Rules will be recognized as being for the vacant Title.

LIGHTMIDDLEWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIP

A decision concerning the long overdue mandatory defence by Jamie Cox against Obodai Sai is anticipated within the next few days. The CBC may be faced with a choice of declaring the Title vacant or ordering a further purse offer bid.

LIGHTWELTERWEIGHT

The voluntary all-Scottish defence by Champion Lee McAllister against Eddie Doyle in Aberdeen, scheduled for tonight (19th October) is postponed due to an injury sustained by the Champion.
