The above contest is now open for negotiations between the parties, or, in the absence of agreement, purse bids.

Purse bids will be opened by the President and Chairman on TUESDAY, 27TH NOVEMBER 2012 at 11.45 am, at :-

Bids may be sent by post or by an appropriate carrier eg UPS, FEDEX etc, or may be delivered personally either by the bidding promoter or a representative. Any bidding promoter or representative present will be invited to witness the opening.

NB: Any bid received after the 11 45 am deadline will be disqualified and only opened, if necessary, for the purpose of identifying the sender for return.

The contest cannot take place prior to 12th JANUARY 2013 without the agreement of both parties and must take place prior to MARCH 31st 2013.

Promoters must specify a date and venue when submitting the bid. A modest extension to the deadline for the contest may be permitted strictly provided the Hon Secretary has been notified prior to close of business Friday 23rd November 2012. What constitutes a 'modest extension' shall be determined by the Chairman and Hon Secretary in their absolute discretion.

Bidding parties must note Term 6 of the 'Terms for Purse Bids' and ensure they have made allowance in their calculations that the purses are nett. The Hon Secretary will advise the winning promoter a final date for submission of contracts to both parties and lodging of CBC Sanction Fee, and both parties a date by which they must be signed and returned. Contracts must be in a form authorized by or approved by the CBC Member Federation or Host Federation.

Purse bids must be delivered in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside 'PO KS/AS', sent to Fountain Court Chambers, marked clearly 'FOR THE ATTENTION OF, AND TO BE OPENED ONLY BY PHILIP BROOK SMITH QC'.
