PLEASE NOTE CAREFULLY

- 1. When a Commonwealth Champion wins a World Championship whether or not recognized by the Council or by any individual member federation of the Council, he shall automatically relinquish the Commonwealth Championship .**
- 2. In view of varying medical standards and requirements for Boxers throughout the Commonwealth, Promoters are urged to ensure that Boxers from abroad competing for Commonwealth Titles are capable of meeting the standards of the host governing authority.**
- 3. It is the obligation of the Champion, and his Manager and any Promoter with whom he is currently working, to meet the defence requirements determined by the Council.**
- 4. There are currently no women Champions, nor listed contenders due to lack of sufficient interest in any weight division. The Council has already decided to introduce these as and when enough Boxers, or their Managers or Promoters, have applied to the Council for Championship or Eliminating contests and it has been determined there are sufficient contenders to make the introduction of a Championship viable in any particular weight division.**
